Can you get a tax break if you install solar panels?

If you installed solar panels before December 31, 2025, you may be in line for a tax break when you file your return. The U.S. government offers a solar tax credit that can reach up to 30% of the cost of installing a system that uses the sun to power your home. NerdWallet's ratings are determined by our editorial team.

Can I claim a tax credit if I install a solar PV system?

Yes, but if the residence where you install a solar PV system serves multiple purposes (e.g., you have a home office or your business is located in the same building), claiming the tax credit can be more complicated.

Which states do not charge sales tax on solar panels?

Five states -- Alaska, Delaware, Montana, New Hampshire and Oregon -- don't charge any sales tax for any purchases. Similar to property tax exemptions, many states will require an application for the sales tax exemption on solar equipment. Which states exempt solar panels from property taxes and sales taxes?

Do you need a property tax exemption for solar panels?

If your house is worth \$300,000, and you install solar panels with a total value of \$20,000, a property tax exemption would keep the assessed value of your house at \$300,000, not \$320,000. In most cases, you will need to apply for a property tax exemption, sometimes before the installation of your solar panels.

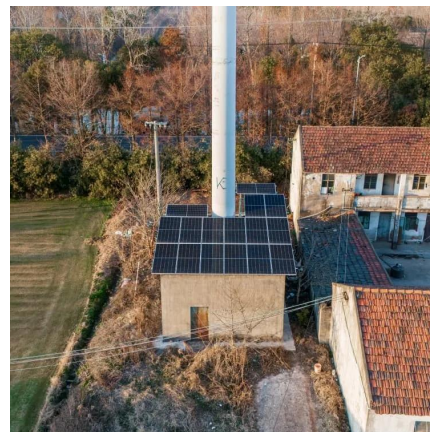

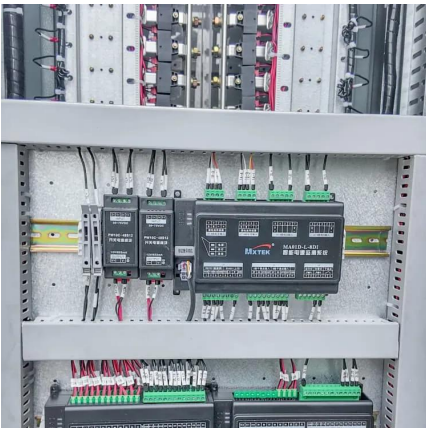
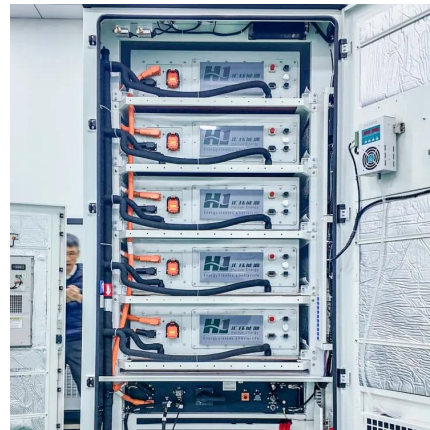
